
More Improvements!!


Interlibrary Loan

If there is a book, or journal article that you must have and it is not available in the Point Park collection or via E-ZBorrow, there is another way!! Please try our our InterLibrary Loan service, placing an order with ILL will open up your request to a national catalog search by our extremely diligent ILL Coordinator. If your request is available anywhere, she will find it for you. If your request cannot be filled via Interlibrary Loan, that means it simply is not there to be had any where in the known universe. It may be available in the void between our world and the next, but it is clearly not in the earthly realm.


