MIKE BRUNO, head coach, sixth season, 104-82 at Point Park, 220-140 overall

Mike Bruno enters his sixth season as head coach at Point Park with a 104-82 record at the school. This is his 11th season as a head volleyball coach on the collegiate level. Bruno is the longest-tenured head coach in the history of the Point Park volleyball program, and he is also the program's all-time leader in victories. In his 10 previous seasons, Bruno has amassed a career record of 220-140, which equates to an average of 22 victories and 14 losses per season.

Since taking over the Point Park program prior to the 2005 season, Bruno has guided the Pioneers to three AMC tournament appearances in five years, which includes a trip to the AMC tournament finals in 2009. Bruno led Point Park to a 32-8 record last season, which was easily the best in school history.

Bruno has been named conference coach of the year on three occasions – once in the AMC (2005) and twice in the President's Athletic Conference as the head coach at Waynesburg from 2000-04. Bruno had a record of 116-58 in five years at Waynesburg, the last two of which included PAC tournament championships.

The native of Apollo, Pa., is a 1990 graduate of Robert Morris University with a degree in sports management. He was a cross country runner for the Colonials for four years.
