Tonight's Matchup

Point Park hosts IU East for the KIAC Women's Basketball Game of the Week. It is the second of two matchups this year for the KIAC Colonial Division opponents. Point Park lost on the road, 65-54, at IU East on Jan. 11. The Pioneers look to even the season series in a key divisional game. IU East has lost two games in a row since beating Point Park. Both teams need to keep winning to stay within the divisional lead, which has Rio Grande leading at 6-1 KIAC but Point Park and IU East not far behind.

All-Time Series

Point Park leads, 2-1. The Pioneers won both meetings last year, 103-79, on the road and 84-67 at home. This is just the second year of IU East women's basketball, so the series started last season.

Last Meeting:

IU East beat Point Park, 65-54, at home Jan. 11. Neither team shot well in a defensive battle as the Pioneers shot 29%, and IU East 27%. Rebounding was the difference with IU East leading, 65-36, on the boards. The Red Wolves' 19 offensive rebounds cancelled out Point Park's 25 forced turnovers. Tia King had 17 points, 11 rebounds. Bailey Dreiman had 18 boards.

POINT PARK TEAM NOTES

Overview: The Pioneers are in search of the KIAC Colonial Division lead having won their last two conference games to pull to a virtual tie with Rio Grande for first place. Rio Grande is 6-1 KIAC compared to Point Park's 7-2, but the Pioneers own a win over the RedStorm. A win today over IU East to return the favor to the Red Wolves would give the Pioneers a key victory in a tight race.

Last Game: Won, 69-54 at Carlow Jan. 19. The Pioneers built a 34-20 lead at halftime and made 10 3-pointers on the night to get the road victory. Alexa Xenakis and Celina DiPietro each had 14 to lead the outside production. Kaitlyn Smith scored 13, and Carly Forse 11. Carlow shot 28% FGs.

Head Coach: Tony Grenek is in his fifth year as head coach of the Pioneers. His record is 115-30 (.793) and he guided Point Park to the NAIA DII national tournament his first three seasons here.

Key Players: The Pioneers have a main rotatin of seven players who all average over 22 minutes, and six of them average between 8.5 and 10.0 ppg. The balanced attack is led by Baylee Buleca and Carly Forse on the inside and Alexa Xenakis and Celina DiPietro on the outside.

Dialing in the "D": Point Park has been putting up a consistent, defensive effort the last 10 games (7-3 record). The Pioneers have held 9 of their last 10 opponents under 65 points with six of those opponents being held under 55 points. The last seven have been 54, 40, 65, 55, 54, 65 and 53.

KIAC Rankings: Point Park's defense is second in the KIAC in scoring defense (61.2 ppg) and FG defense (.354). The offense is fifth in the KIAC in scoring (69.4 ppg) and fifth in assists (13.6 apg).

IU East: The Red Wolves were 5-0 KIAC when they beat Point Park but have since lost the last two at Rio Grande (90-77) and at WVU Tech (80-79). Another tough road game comes today, and they are 2-7 on the road. Tia King is a top player in the conference ranking second in the KIAC in scoring. Kristen Miller is also in double digits. Bailey Dreiman is the leading rebounder at 5-foot-4.
