<b>Verify your name and address</b> on your institutional records and if incorrect complete a Change of Name/Address Form in the Office of the Registrar. Please make sure to update your DIPLOMA ADDRESS, as this is where your diploma will be mailed.
Complete the Graduation Application online at <a href="https://www.pointpark.edu/about/admindepts/registrarsoffice/studentresources/graduation">https://www.pointpark.edu/about/admindepts/registrarsoffice/studentresources/graduation</a>
<b>Purchase academic regalia</b> (cap, gown and tassel). These items can be ordered at the Graduation Fair, held on campus February 20-21. If you are unable to attend the Graduation Fair: order at the Point Park University Bookstore before March 17, or order online before March 27. Honors cords can be obtained in the Office of the Registrar on the 9 <sup>th</sup> Floor of Thayer Hall.
<b>Pick up 10 free commencement announcements</b> at the Graduation Fair.
<b>Pick up honors cords</b> (if applicable). The Honors designation requires a 3.5 or higher cumulative GPA as of the end of the Fall 2023 term. Honors cords are for undergraduates only.
<b>RSVP online by April 12, 2024</b> if you plan to attend Commencement, please RSVP by clicking this <u>link</u> .
Clear any financial obligations with the University.
Participate in the Point Park University Commencement. You must be properly attired and present your Student Calling Card (you will receive this at check-in) to participate in Commencement.
<b>Diploma will be mailed within four to six weeks</b> of the end of your last term of attendance.

*Important:* You <u>must</u> be properly attired (cap and gown) to participate in Commencement. Failure to do so will result in exclusion from the ceremony.
