3D Animation - June 24 to June 28, 2019

Easy to learn and extremely powerful: Cinema 4D is the perfect package for all 3D artists who want to achieve breathtaking results. In this course, led by Jonathan Trueblood, students will explore the core techniques needed to create 3D models and animation. Students will learn the basics of how to plan a Cinema 4D project, how to animate the camera, add lighting, create and apply materials, organize and render the project, and more. This class culminates in a screening of all final projects for family and friends on the last day. This class is intended for students interested in learning the process of animation.

2D Animation - July 15 to July 19, 2019

Want to learn how to make your own animated cartoons? Come and learn the fundamentals of 2D CHARACTER ANIMATION at Point Park University this summer. In this 5-day intensive workshop, led by Jonathan Trueblood, students will explore the art of 2D Animation, using the industry standard software. Learn how to take a character and bring them and your world to life. This class culminates in a screening of all final projects for family and friends on the last day.
