Bachelor of Fine Arts in Contemporary Theatre Making: Directing, Devising, and Playwriting

The Bachelor of Fine Arts in Contemporary Theatre Making cultivates the multiple talents and interests of creative students seeking to explore, challenge and advance the art and craft of making theatre. This unique and flexible program immerses students in generative theatre practices, with hands-on opportunities for collaborations with other Conservatory arts programs.

The program allows the student flexibility and autonomy to study, experience, and integrate a variety of theatrical disciplines and related fields. In addition to their major courses, students may choose from various areas of emphasis within the Conservatory of Performing Arts to continue their course of study: Directing, Playwriting, or a Self-Directed concentration. Additionally, students have options to pursue a minor in a related field such as: Tech/Design; Stage Management; Cinema Studies; Screenwriting; Sports, Arts, and Entertainment Management; Education; and so on. Students can double major, study abroad and/or complete the degree in three years (with summer coursework.) The program also offers the opportunity to add an additional M.A., M.F.A. or M.B.A., achievable with this degree with 4.5 years of schooling.
