Professional Studies

PROF 501 Seminar in Professional Studies

Students in Seminar in Professional Studies will examine the current issues relevant to their chosen fields of study. In addition, students will engage with students studying other disciplines to identify areas of commonality and difference. The course includes an overview of the academic research process, to enable students to succeed in their current and future coursework.

PROF 590 Capstone Proposal Seminar

The Capstone Proposal Seminar requires students to synthesize the learning from their chosen fields and prove their comprehensive knowledge of both. Students will create a detailed proposal for their capstone project, including literature review and planned method for research or creation of a project. Prerequisite: PROF 501

PROF 591 Capstone Project

The Capstone Project course requires students to synthesize the learning from chosen fields and prove their comprehensive knowledge of both. Students will execute the research plan or project proposal created in the Capstone Proposal Seminar. Prerequisite: PROF 590
