This forty-eight (48) credit program is designed as a three-to-four-term sequence for students who enter Point Park University with a B.A. or B.S. degree in an area other than Accounting. A student must successfully complete a minimum of thirty (30) credits at Point Park University to receive a Baccalaureate degree from Point Park -- a minimum of twelve (12) of the thirty (30) credits must be in Accounting.
