Point Park was founded in 1933 and was a member of the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) from 1967 to July 2024. Point Park University entered the 3 year NCAA membership process in July 2024 and has successfully completed year 1 of the 3 year NCAA membership process as of July 10, 2025. It is a member of the Mountain East Conference (MEC).

In its 50 years of existence, the Pioneers athletic department has won numerous conference championships and has been represented at many NAIA national championship events. The first year in the NCAA and Mountain East Conference (MEC) Point Park Pioneer Baseball won the conference championship.

The Pioneers sponsored 19 varsity sports that competed at the intercollegiate level. Athletic scholarships were awarded to student-athletes as allowed by the NACC during 2024-25.
