Professional Licensure

The Point Park Master's Program in Clinical-Community Counseling program is a 60-credit program that will lead to state licensure as a Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC). Graduates will be eligible for licensure upon successful completion of the program once all requirements for experience and examinations have been satisfied. Each state may have its own or additional requirements to lead to licensure. In some states, for graduates of non-CACREP accredited programs, the applicant is required to contact the Center for Credentialing and Education, Inc. (CCE) to obtain a content equivalency evaluation and report.
